



HORACE "HANK" JOHNSON
1931-2018

It is with great sadness that we announce the loss of our dear friend and colleague, Horace A. "Hank" Johnson, who passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, September 16, 2018. A lifelong Pennsylvania resident, Hank graduated from East Stroudsburg University before serving his country as a Captain in the U.S. Army. He graduated from the Dickinson School of Law in 1958 and earned a Masters of Laws Degree in taxation from New York University in 1962. Hank joined this firm, then known as Myers, Myers & Flower, in 1963 and quickly became one of the most respected attorneys in southcentral Pennsylvania.

Over the course of his long career, Hank represented countless clients with great alacrity and integrity, and derived great pleasure in mentoring young attorneys in the practice of law. In addition to his professional achievements, Hank was a community leader. He served on the governing boards of numerous governmental, civic, and church organizations.
